Details on entering the country and the start of the academic year – August 5th, 2022

Dear Student,

Congratulations on your being a DAFM Student!

On behalf of the Management of **Hungarian University of Agriculture and Life Sciences, MATE International Relations Team** is happy to welcome you soon. To provide you with assistance, this message is to guide you with the current rules and regulations which apply in our country regarding entering.

After the receipt of your Letter of Acceptance and Letter of Award, you can start to arrange your visa process and the preparations for entering Hungary. Our university is getting prepared for **an offline academic year** at the moment; however, future governmental regulations are to be obeyed. The academic year begins on 5th September with our [Orientation Week](#). Classes for 1st year students start on 12th September.

At the moment, there is no restriction due to Covid-19 in Hungary. The state of emergency was ended and travel restrictions previously imposed due to the epidemic situation were lifted on 7th March, 2022. Please, note that 1st-year Erasmus Mundus DAFM students can only be provided accommodation in the dorm **on their own cost** and in case they apply for accommodation via the [Hostel Application Form](#) until August 10th. If there is **any change** about your planned arrival date, **you are obliged to inform the hostel within the shortest possible time. Your booked room in the dorm will not be saved for you for more than 5 days after your registered date of arrival**, since there is a huge demand for dormitory places. **You should also inform your educational coordinator Ms. Kinga Szabados** (Puspokne.Szabados.Kinga@uni-mate.hu) and non-educational coordinator Ms. Zita Batiz (batiz.zita@uni-mate.hu)

All students are required to fill in the [Arrival Form](#) to inform our Institution and the dormitories of the details of their arrival. You are entitled to a free ride from the airport to the dormitory upon arrival.
